
Job Aid: How is Infection Spread?



WHO?	HOW?
Healthcare Worker -> Patient	If HCW has unwashed hands, uses contaminated sharps, such as needles syringes, lancets or other blood drawing or invasive devices uses improperly cleaned, reusable equipment.
Patient -> Healthcare Worker	If HCW is stuck by contaminated sharp from patient is splashed by blood or body fluids from a patient with a bloodborne disease especially when HCW has an open wound inhales infectious particles from a patient who coughs, sneezes or is close (patient breath, talking).
Patient -> Patient	If HCW between patients • does not wash hands and change gloves • uses unsterilized equipment.
Healthcare Worker -> Family	If HCW: disposes of medical waste and sharps improperly goes home with unwashed hands, a soiled uniform, clothing or shoes.
